# RPFC - ABOUT US

Reigate Priory's history can be traced right back to 1870, not long after the FA was actually formed in 1863.

In 1871, the club was one of only 15 teams that contested for a £20 silver trophy, the first ever FA Challenge Cup competition.

Reigate Priory were also present when the Surrey FA (founded in 1887) decided to become affiliated to the FA on the 16th March 1882. The club was one of the original 10 teams present at the meeting that took place in Guildford.

At the same time a County Senior Cup competition was introduced. The first winners of the Surrey Senior Cup were Reigate Priory who were victorious six times before the end of the century.

Priory also made an excursion into European Football in 1910 where they won the International Cup du Nord beating Cercle Athletique Paris 3-0 in the Final.

The Reigate Priory Veterans (over 35's) continues to be an integral part of the club, enabling ex players, coaches, managers and club officials to meet up regularly and play other established Vets sides.

Reigate Priory continue to expand its Youth Section and will be represented by over 50 Youth Teams from as young as 9 to as old as 18. The junior teams have fed the men's teams with many of our exciting young players. The Youth Section have also been awarded FA Charter Standard status.

Reigate Priory continues to develop with an increasing number of teams for the new season enabling the club to provide an extended football experience catering for a variety of levels. Each year we welcome new members to Reigate Priory, so if you are interested in joining an established, friendly and sociable club then please don't hesitate to contact us.

## Manager's Notes



GOOD AFTERNOON AND WELCOME TO PARK LANE,

AAAAAND WE'RE BACK. IT FEELS LIKE IT'S BEEN AN ETERNITY SINCE OUR LAST COMPETITIVE FIXTURE. THE LAST TIME I WAS PERSONALLY IN THE DUGOUT WAS THE END OF NOVEMBER IN OUR CUP TIE WITH FRENCHES ATHLETIC, SO I'M EXCITED TO BE BACK TODAY FOR THIS CLASH AGAINST LINDFIELD WHO CURRENTLY SIT 2ND IN THE LEAGUE.

THE BREAK OVER DECEMBER HAS BEEN A BIT FRUSTRATING WITH 2 GAMES POSTPONED DUE TO THE WEATHER, BUT IT HAS ENABLED A FEW PLAYERS TO SHAKE OFF INJURY. THE LADS TOOK IT UPON THEMSELVES TO BOOK A 7-A-SIDE COURT TO TRY AND KEEP THEMSELVES SHARP OVER THIS PERIOD, BUT OF COURSE NOTHING REALLY COMPARES TO ACTUAL COMPETITIVE 11-A-SIDE FOOTBALL, SO THIS GAME WILL BE A GOOD OPPORTUNITY TO ASSESS MATCH SHARPNESS ACROSS THE SQUAD. PLAYERS RETURNING TO TRAINING FROM INJURY INCLUDES JAMES WOOD, KIERAN DENNEHY AND SHANE O'KEEFFE WHILST NICK WALSH AND JOSH WILLE ARE TAKING PART IN LIGHT TRAINING. ALEX BICKNELL IS STILL SUSPENDED CURRENTLY, MATT ELDRIDGE IS STILL OUT WITH A LONG-TERM INJURY AND NEITHER SCOTT JOHNSON NOR JACOB WIELD ARE AVAILABLE.

LINDFIELD HAVE HAD A GREAT START TO THE SEASON AND WE'LL BE KEEN TO GET ONE BACK OVER THEM TO DRAG OURSELVES BACK INTO CONTENTION FOR 2ND PLACE. HAVING FALLEN BEHIND ON GAMES PLAYED WITH 3 GAMES IN HAND OVER LINDFIELD, WE ALSO LOST 3-2 TO THEM EARLIER IN THE SEASON HAVING TAKEN A 2 GOAL LEAD, WITH MULTIPLE CHANCES TO EXTEND THAT LEAD BEFORE HALF-TIME. A VERY SUSPECT GOAL JUST BEFORE THE BREAK GAVE LINDFIELD A WAY BACK INTO THE GAME AND WITH MOMENTUM ON THEIR SIDE, THEY CRANKED UP THE PRESSURE IN THE 2ND HALF WHICH UNFORTUNATELY, WE CRUMBLLED UNDER AND 2 POOR ERRORS OF JUDGEMENT AT THE BACK GIFTED POSSESSION IN A DANGEROUS AREA, LEADING TO 2 GOALS AND ULTIMATELY COST US THE GAME. I'LL BE LOOKING FOR A MUCH STRONGER MENTALITY TODAY FROM OUR LADS WHO RESPONDED WELL TO THAT, ENSURING WE HAVEN'T LOST SINCE THAT FIXTURE.

LINDFIELD HAVE PLAYED SLIGHTLY MORE RECENTLY THAN US, SECURING AN IMPORTANT 3-2 WIN ON THE 10TH DECEMBER AGAINST A BALCOMBE SIDE WHO ARE ALSO HOPING TO STAKE A CLAIM FOR THAT 2ND PLACE. RUARI FARRELL WILL LIKELY BE THE 'OBVIOUS' MAN TO WATCH FOR LINDFIELD WHO HAS 18 GOALS AND 12 ASSISTS IN JUST 15 APPEARANCES, INCLUDING A GOAL AGAINST US EARLIER IN THE SEASON. HOWEVER, IN THE REVERSE FIXTURE IT WAS ANDREW BROWN WHO CAME OFF THE BENCH AND DISMANTLED US IN THE SECOND HALF WITH HIS PRESS AND COMPOSURE ON THE BALL. HE HAS 10 GOAL CONTRIBUTIONS IN 15 APPEARANCES THIS SEASON.

I'M EXPECTING THIS TO BE A VERY TOUGH GAME, BUT IT'D BE A HUGE CONFIDENCE BOOST TO HEAD INTO OUR CLASH WITH TOP OF THE LEAGUE NEXT WEEK OFF THE BACK OF 3 POINTS AGAINST THE 2ND PLACED SIDE.

# MATCH REPORT VS WESTFIELD- 3RD DEC 2022

REIGATE PRIORY MADE THE LONG TRIP TO WESTFIELD NEAR HASTINGS ON SATURDAY AND WITH A NUMBER OF PLAYERS MISSING, IT MEANT RETURNS TO THE STARTING ELEVEN FOR DAVID MCLAUGHLIN AND JAMES LONG AND RECALLS TO THE BENCH FOR MARCUS BEST-OSBORNE, CAPP A HUGHES AND CLUB CAPTAIN SCOTT JOHNSON. PRIORY STARTED THE BRIGHTER SIDE WITH A STRONG PRESS AND CHRIS PARSONS AT LEFT BACK FINDING HIMSELF WITH LOTS OF TIME ON THE BALL, ENABLING HIM TO REPEATEDLY FIND CALLUM JOHNSON DOWN THE LEFT HAND SIDE. THE FIRST CLEAR-CUT CHANCE CAME FROM A PARSONS WHIPPED FREE-KICK WHICH CAUSED HAVOC WITH THE WESTFIELD GOALKEEPER BEFORE FALLING TO MAX BICKNELL WHO COULD ONLY FIRE OVER THE BAR. BICKNELL'S YOUNGER BROTHER ALEX THEN WENT CLOSE WITH A POWERFUL RUN FROM RIGHT BACK TO THE EDGE OF THE WESTFIELD BOX BEFORE FIRING SLIGHTLY WIDE OF THE LEFT HAND POST. TEN MINUTES BEFORE HALF-TIME, SOMEWHAT AGAINST THE RUN OF PLAY, IT WAS THE TURN OF WESTFIELD TO DELIVER A DELIGHTFUL FREE KICK INTO THE BACK POST FOR HARRY MURPHY TO CALMLY HEAD IN PUTTING THE HOME SIDE 1-0 UP. WESTFIELD DOUBLED THEIR LEAD MID-WAY THROUGH THE SECOND HALF WHEN PRIORY'S CHRIS PARSONS INADVERTENTLY PLAYED THROUGH FORMER MILLWALL YOUTH AND IRELAND U16 ATTACKER GEORGE LANDAIS, WHO SHIFTED THE BALL ONTO HIS RIGHT BEATING SCOTT JOHNSON BEFORE NEATLY FINISHING IN THE BOTTOM LEFT CORNER. PRIORY'S RESPONSE WAS IMMEDIATE THOUGH WHEN TOM HAYDEN LIFTED THE BALL IN BEHIND THE WESTFIELD LEFT BACK FOR SUBSTITUTE MARCUS BEST-OSBORNE TO LATCH ONTO, CUTTING THE BALL BACK FROM THE BYLINE TO MAX BICKNELL ON THE EDGE OF THE BOX, WHO WONDERFULLY WHIPPED HIS SHOT INTO THE TOP RIGHT HAND CORNER. IT SEEMED AS THOUGH PRIORY'S COMEBACK WAS SHORT-LIVED AS ALEX BICKNELL WAS THEN GIVEN HIS MARCHING ORDERS FOR A CYNICAL FOUL, BUT THIS PRIORY SIDE JUST DOESN'T KNOW WHEN IT'S BEATEN. HAVING FOUGHT OFF AN ONSLAUGHT FOLLOWING THE RED CARD, MAX BICKNELL'S TESTING CORNER WAS STEERED TOWARDS GOAL BY SCOTT JOHNSON BEFORE DEFLECTING OFF A DEFENDER INTO THE FAR CORNER TO MAKE IT 2-2, WHICH IS HOW THE GAME FINISHED LEAVING BOTH THE TEAMS MID TABLE IN THE MID SUSSEX PREMIER LEAGUE.

MANAGER DALE WYATT COMMENTED: "IT'S DISAPPOINTING TO LOSE ALEX BICKNELL FOR A FEW GAMES WHO HAD PLAYED BRILLIANTLY UP UNTIL HIS DISMISSAL WHICH WAS A SLIGHT LACK OF JUDGEMENT ON HIS PART, HOWEVER IT'S VERY PLEASING TO SEE THE REACTION OF THE LADS TO GOING TWO GOALS DOWN AND TO THEN FIGHT TO A 2-2 DRAW DESPITE BEING A MAN DOWN. IT FELT LIKE A GROUP OF LADS DETERMINED NOT TO ALLOW ALEX TO FEEL LIKE HIS MISTAKE HAD COST THE TEAM AND THEY RALLIED AROUND FOR HIM. WE'RE NOW EIGHT GAMES UNBEATEN AND GOING INTO TWO HOME GAMES AT PARK LANE BEFORE CHRISTMAS, SO WE ARE HOPEFUL OF A STRONG FINISH TO THE YEAR!"

# GENERATION CUP



On Saturday 11 November 1871, Clapham Rovers' Jarvis Kenrick scored the first ever goal in The FA Challenge Cup against Upton Park FC.

150 years later, nine clubs (including Reigate Priory FC) that were involved in the inaugural edition of the world's most historic knockout cup competition are participating in a special tournament to celebrate the anniversary. The competition's format will see three groups of three teams take to the grass for 60-minute matches and the winners of each group will progress to the finals which will be played on the elite-level pitches at St. George's Park. Each club will enter a 24-player squad, with no more than five players under the age of 40 and three players over the age of 50 required to be on the pitch at all times.
