# RPFC - ABOUT US

Reigate Priory's history can be traced right back to 1870, not long after the FA was actually formed in 1863.

In 1871, the club was one of only 15 teams that contested for a £20 silver trophy, the first ever FA Challenge Cup competition.

Reigate Priory were also present when the Surrey FA (founded in 1887) decided to become affiliated to the FA on the 16th March 1882. The club was one of the original 10 teams present at the meeting that took place in Guildford.

At the same time a County Senior Cup competition was introduced. The first winners of the Surrey Senior Cup were Reigate Priory who were victorious six times before the end of the century.

Priory also made an excursion into European Football in 1910 where they won the International Cup du Nord beating Cercle Athletique Paris 3-0 in the Final.

The Reigate Priory Veterans (over 35's) continues to be an integral part of the club, enabling ex players, coaches, managers and club officials to meet up regularly and play other established Vets sides.

Reigate Priory continue to expand its Youth Section and will be represented by over 50 Youth Teams from as young as 9 to as old as 18. The junior teams have fed the men's teams with many of our exciting young players. The Youth Section have also been awarded FA Charter Standard status.

Reigate Priory continues to develop with an increasing number of teams for the new season enabling the club to provide an extended football experience catering for a variety of levels. Each year we welcome new members to Reigate Priory, so if you are interested in joining an established, friendly and sociable club then please don't hesitate to contact us.

## Manager's Notes



GOOD AFTERNOON AND WELCOME TO PARK LANE,

TODAY WE WELCOME ASHURST WOOD TO PARK LANE WHO GOT PROMOTED FROM THE CHAMPIONSHIP WITH US, BUT ARE CURRENTLY STRUGGLING A LITTLE BIT TO FIND THEIR FEET. THEY CAME FLYING OUT OF THE BLOCKS LAST SEASON AND WERE THE TEAM TO BEAT EARLY ON. WE MET THEM WHILST FINDING SOME GOOD MOMENTUM OURSELVES AND THE STRONG WIN AT THEIR PLACE WAS THE CATALYST TO GOING ON TO WIN THE DIVISION. WE THEN MET THEM 1ST GAME OF THIS SEASON AND HAVING GONE DOWN A GOAL TWICE, WE FOUGHT BACK TO STEAL THE 3 POINTS WITH AN EDGY 3-2 VICTORY. # MATCH REPORTS



REIGATE PRIORY HOSTED HIGH-FLYING BATTLE TOWN IN AN ENTERTAINING FIXTURE AT PARK LANE ON SATURDAY. AFTER A SLOW START TO THE SEASON, THE VISITORS HAD BEEN ON A STRONG RUN THAT HAS SEEN THEM REACH THIRD PLACE IN THE MID-SUSSEX PREMIER LEAGUE. HOWEVER, IT WAS PRIORY THAT STARTED THE BETTER AND AFTER JUST TEN MINUTES CALLUM JOHNSON'S SHOT FROM THE EDGE OF THE BOX SNUCK INTO THE CORNER OF THE NET FOR ONE NIL. PRIORY'S LEAD WAS FAIRLY SHORT-LIVED AND THE LIVELY PAUL WETHERBY NOTCHED HIS SEVENTH LEAGUE GOAL OF THE SEASON CUTTING BACK ON TO HIS LEFT FOOT AND FINISHING PAST CALLUM WALMSLEY ON HIS HOME DEBUT, TO LEVEL THE SCORES. WEATHERBY GRABBED A SECOND EARLY IN THE SECOND HALF AND SHOULD HAVE COMPLETED HIS HAT-TRICK AFTER SEVENTY MINUTES BUT BLAZED WIDE WHEN WELL-PLACED. WITH FIFTEEN MINUTES TO GO FANS' FAVOURITE JAMES BOLTON CAME OFF THE BENCH AND WITHIN MINUTES BROKE FREE OF THE BATTLE TOWN DEFENCE AND COOLLY SLOTTED PAST THE GOALKEEPER TO EQUALISE. PRIORY MAY HAVE BEEN AWARDED A PENALTY LATE ON WHEN SHANE O'KEEFFE WAS BLOCKED OFF BY A DEFENDER IN THE PENALTY BOX BUT THE REFEREE INSTEAD AWARDED AN INDIRECT FREEKICK WHICH WAS SET TO O'KEEFFE WHO SLICED WIDE. THE GAME ENDED ALL SQUARE, 2-2. MANAGER DALE WYATT HAD THIS TO SAY, 'IT WAS A TOUGH FIXTURE TODAY, BUT ANOTHER ONE WHERE YET AGAIN WE WILL RUE MISSED CHANCES. ON THE BALANCE OF PLAY, I THINK WE JUST ABOUT EDGED IT. THE TWO GOALS THEY SCORED WERE ALMOST GIFTED, NOT TO TAKE AWAY FROM WEATHERBY THOUGH BECAUSE HE STILL HAD A BIT TO DO AND TOOK HIS CHANCES WELL. UNFORTUNATELY, THAT'S SOMETHING WE DIDN'T DO WELL ENOUGH WITH TWO SITTERS MISSED AND A PENALTY RIGHT AT THE END NOT AWARDED. WE'VE NOW FALLEN BEHIND TARGET FOR THE MONTH AND HAVE GIVEN OURSELVES A LOT TO DO IN THE PURSUIT OF 4TH PLACE.

REIGATE PRIORY RESERVES TRAVELLED TO CRAWLEY UNITED IN THE QUARTER-FINALS OF THE EDGAR GERMAN CUP. A BELOW-PAR PERFORMANCE FROM PRIORY SAW THEM LEVEL AT HALF TIME, BUT CHANGES AT THE BREAK SAW AN INJECTION OF INTENSITY WITH THE BEST CHANCE FALLING TO OLLIE ROSE WHO NARROWLY MISSED THE TARGET. BUT PRIORY HEART'S WERE BROKEN IN THE 75TH MINUTE, WHEN ROSS MCDONALD WON THE GAME WITH A POWER HEADER FROM A CORNER.

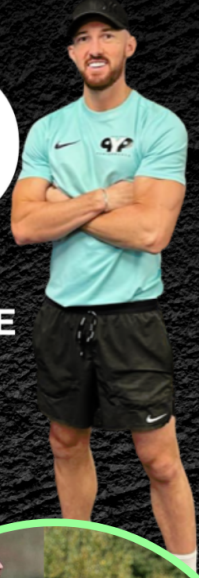

# RESERVE TEAM SEASON SO FAR



REIGATE PRIORY RESERVES ARE NOW PAST THE HALFWAY POINT OF THE SEASON, HAVING JUST THE LEAGUE TO PLAY FOR AFTER BEING KNOCKED OUT IN THE QUARTER-FINALS STAGES OF TWO DIFFERENT COMPETITIONS, NARROWLY LOSING ON BOTH OCCASIONS.

4 GAMES INTO THE SEASON, RICKY DE ABREU WHO STARTED THE SEASON AS B TEAM MANAGER GOT PROMOTED TO SUPPORT MYSELF (BEN SMYTHE) WHICH FORMED A NEW MANAGEMENT TEAM THAT SAW INSTANT SUCCESS, WINNING 5 LEAGUE GAMES OUT OF 6.

WITH NOW 8 LEAGUE GAMES TO GO, IT SEEMS LIKE IT'S GOING TO BE A COMPETITIVE END TO THE SEASON WITH 5 TEAMS ALL PLAYING FOR THAT TOP SPOT, SEPARATED BY 4POINTS. PLEASEING THOUGH THAT WE ARE ONE OF THOSE 5 TEAMS.

THROUGHOUT THE SEASON WE HAVE HAD SOME POSITIVE PLAYER MOVEMENTS. WE HAVE HELPED THE FIRST TEAM BY PROMOTING TWO PLAYERS BACK UP TO THEM (JAMES BOLTON & HARRISON SPICER) AFTER GAINING FITNESS/CONFIDENCE WITH US. AFTER 6 GAMES IN, IT WAS REWARDING TO SEE THAT OUR CAPTAIN PAUL COOMBER GOT A FULL-TIME CALL-UP TO FIRSTS AFTER CONSISTENT PERFORMANCES STRETCHING OVER A LONG PERIOD.

IN RETURN, DUE TO THE STRENGTH IN DEPTH ABOVE US, PLAYERS HAVE COME TO US TO RETURN WHICH HAS HELPED MASSIVELY IN RECENT MONTHS.

ALSO WANTED TO ADD THAT WE HAVE CALLED UP HARRY JOYLES, A YOUNG PROMISING CB FROM THE B'S FULL-TIME WHO GOT BACK-TO-BACK MAN OF THE MATCH IN HIS FIRST 2 GAMES AS WELL AS JUDE O'CONNOR ON AN AD-HOC BASIS TO HELP HIS DEVELOPMENT/EXPERIENCE.

REIGATE PRIORY B TEAM'S SEASON SO FAR HAS SEEN SOME HIGHS AND LOWS BUT ULTIMATELY A VERY POSITIVE ONE!

GIFTED THE 3 POINTS FROM THE OPPOSITION FORFEITING OUR FIRST GAME, THEN BEATING A DIVISION 4 TEAM IN A CUP WITH AN INCREDIBLE PERFORMANCE HAD US FLYING HIGH AT THE START OF THE SEASON BREEDING A GREAT ATMOSPHERE TAKING US FORWARD INTO 2 WINS AND 2 DRAWS AGAINST DECENT COMPETITION, UNTIL WE WERE HUMBLLED BY A 6-2 DEFEAT. AS THE 4TH TEAM OF A FOOTBALL CLUB, I'M IMPRESSED BY THE COMPETITION FOR POSITIONS FROM THE PLAYERS, OLDER EXPERIENCED PLAYERS PUSHING HARD AND YOUNG LADS LEARNING FAST! ALL CREATING A POSITIVE, COMPETITIVE ENVIRONMENT NOT ONLY IN THE B TEAM, WHICH IS REFLECTED IN THE STRONG LEAGUE POSITION AND INTERNAL PLAYER MOVEMENT, BUT THE CLUB AS A WHOLE.

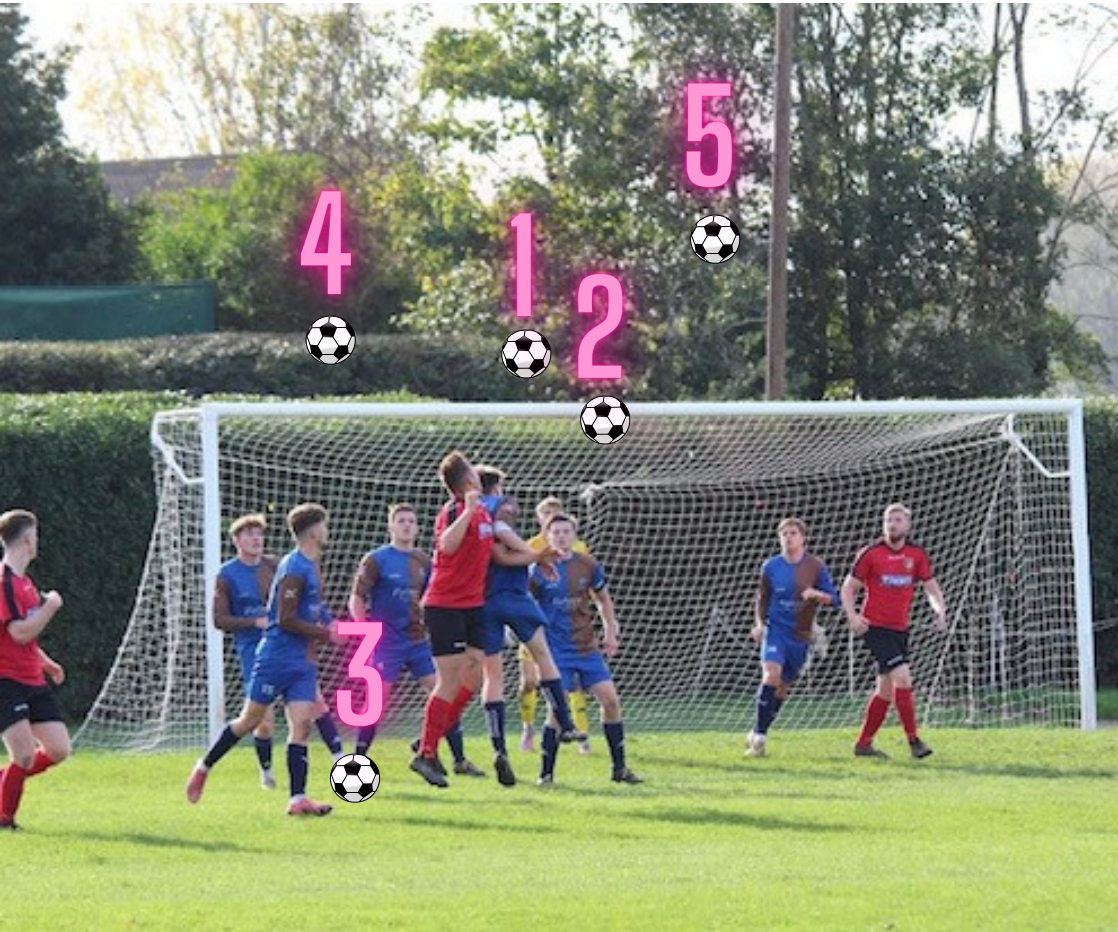
