ABOUT US

Reigate Priory's history can be traced right back to 1870, not long after the FA was actually formed in 1863.

In 1871, the club was one of only 15 teams that contested for a £20 silver trophy, the first ever FA Challenge Cup competition.

Reigate Priory were also present when the Surrey FA (founded in 1887) decided to become affiliated to the FA on the 16th March 1882. The club was one of the original 10 teams present at the meeting that took place in Guildford.

At the same time a County Senior Cup competition was introduced. The first winners of the Surrey Senior Cup were Reigate Priory who were victorious six times before the end of the century.

Priory also made an excursion into European Football in 1910 where they won the International Cup du Nord beating Cercle Athletique Paris 3-0 in the Final.

The Reigate Priory Veterans (over 35's) continues to be an integral part of the club, enabling ex players, coaches, managers and club officials to meet up regularly and play other established Vets sides.

Reigate Priory continue to expand its Youth Section and will be represented by over 50 Youth Teams from as young as 9 to as old as 18. The junior teams have fed the men's teams with many of our exciting young players. The Youth Section have also been awarded FA Charter Standard status.

Reigate Priory continues to develop with an increasing number of teams for the new season enabling the club to provide an extended football experience catering for a variety of levels. Each year we welcome new members to Reigate Priory, so if you are interested in joining an established, friendly and sociable club then please don't hesitate to contact us.

MANAGER'S NOTES

GOOD AFTERNOON AND WELCOME BACK TO THE NEW DEFENCE FOR THE 1ST INSTALMENT OF 3 CONSECUTIVE HOME FIXTURES.

SINCE WE WERE LAST YEAR V COPTHORNE II, WE'VE HAD AN AWAY FIXTURE LINDFIELD POSTPONED AND THEN THE BIG ONE V EASTBOURNE UTD ASSOCIATION. GIVEN HOW SKEWED THE AMOUNT OF GAMES PLAYED ACROSS THE LEAGUE ARE, WE'RE LOOKING AT POINT PER GAME (PPG) AND WITH EASTBOURNE ON 2.2 PPG COMPARED TO OUR 2.15 PPG, THEY ARE ARGUABLY OUR BIGGEST THREAT. THAT COUPLED WITH THE FACT THEY ARE LARGELY THE HOLLINGTON TEAM WHICH ABSOLUTELY CLEANED UP THE DIVISION LAST SEASON.

WE WENT DOWN THERE 10 POINTS AHEAD BUT WITH THEIR 5 GAMES IN HAND, BOTH SIDES KNEW THAT A LOSS WOULD TIP CONTROL INTO THE OTHERS HANDS. WE DESERVEDLY TOOK THE LEAD THROUGH CALLUM JOHNSON WHO LATCHED ONTO A MATT HARRINGTON DEEP CROSS, TAKING ADVANTAGE OF THE EASTBOURNE KEEPER BEING CAUGHT IN NO-MANS LAND AND NODDING IT OVER HIM. HAVING DOMINATED THE OPENING 20-25 MINUTES, WE WEREN'T QUITE ABLE TO TURN IN A 2ND TO GIVE US A BIT OF BREATHING SPACE AND EASTBOURNE GRADUALLY MADE THEIR WAY BACK INTO THE GAME AS THEY STARTED FINDING AN OUT BALL WITH SOME LONG DIAGONAL PASSES. ONE OF WHICH LEAD TO A CORNER AND IN THE WINDY CONDITIONS, A MID-JUDGED HEADER ALLOWED FOR THE BALL TO DROP IN THE 6 YARD BOX TO A GRATEFUL JAMIE CRONE WHO TURNED IN THE EQUALISER FOR EASTBOURNE. THE HOSTS HAD A GLORIOUS CHANCE MIDWAY THROUGH THE SECOND HALF AS CRONE BROKE IN BEHIND PRIORY'S CALLUM RICE AT LEFT BACK BEFORE PICKING OUT A PINPOINT CROSS TO FIND EASTBOURNE TALISMAN PAUL ROGERS FOR THE FIRST TIME ALL GAME. ROGERS WHO IS USUALLY MR RELIABLE IN FRONT OF GOAL COULD ONLY HEAD OVER HAVING BEEN PUT OFF BY JUMPING SKIPPER JOE ELBISHLAWI JUST IN FRONT OF HIM. THIS WAS A BIT OF A WAKE UP CALL FOR PRIORY WHO THEN GOT MAN OF THE MATCH HARRY DOWNER IN DOWN THE LEFT, BUT HE WAS ONLY ABLE TO FIRE OVER THE BAR AS WELL. CALLUM JOHNSON THEN HAD A GLORIOUS CHANCE TO STEAL ALL 3 POINTS WITH MINUTES REMAINING FROM MAX BICKNELL'S CROSS INTO THE 6 YARD BOX, BUT OPTED TO TRY AND TAKE A TOUCH ON HIS CHEST WHICH TOOK HIM WIDE OF THE GOAL. VICE SKIPPER JOHNSON WAS ALSO THE SUBJECT OF A HUGE PENALTY APPEAL WHEN HE WAS TRIPPED IN THE BOX, BUT THE REFEREE CLAIMED HE DIDN'T HAVE A VIEW OF IT WHEN JUST ABOUT EVERYONE ELSE DID. FINALLY, THE EASTBOURNE KEEPER WENT WALKABOUTS AGAIN AND WHEN THE BALL FELL TO MAX BICKNELL TO TAP INTO AN OPEN NET FROM JUST OUTSIDE THE BOX, HE WAS CLEANED OUT WITH FREE KICK AWARDED, BUT BIZARRELY NO CARD. A DRAW ISN'T A BAD RESULT AT ALL, WITH JORDAN MARKEY HAVING TO MAKE 2 GOOD SAVES WITH HIS FEET FROM FIERCE LONG-RANGE STRIKES, BUT ON REFLECTION WE REALLY OUGHT TO HAVE WON IT AT THE END.

WESTFIELD HAVE CONTINUED THEIR STRONG FORM AND ARE CHARGING UP BEHIND US IN 2ND PLACE JUST 6 POINTS OFF, WHICH MAKES OUR WIN AGAINST THEM A FEW WEEKS AGO THAT EVEN MORE IMPORTANT. BALCOMBE AND RINGMER BOTH NOW HAVE A GAME IN HAND EACH OVER US WHICH COULD SEE THEM 4 AND 5 POINTS BEHIND US RESPECTIVELY, SO THE REMAINING FIXTURES OF THIS MONTH AGAINST CRAWLEY DEVILS TODAY, HOLLAND SPORTS NEXT WEEKEND AND THEN BATTLE TOWN ON 30TH MARCH ARE REALLY IMPORTANT TO KEEP UP AHEAD GOING INTO OUR FINAL 3 AGAINST OXTED, EASTBOURNE AND LINDFIELD.

ONTO CRAWLEY DEVILS WHO DESPITE NOT PLAYING THEM LAST SEASON, ARE A FAMILIAR RIVAL. WE'VE HAD SOME BRILLIANT CLASHES WITH THEM DURING OUR CHAMPIONSHIP CAMPAIGNS WITH 2 DRAWS AND A VERY NARROW 1-0 WIN AT HOME. DEVILS EARNED PROMOTION LAST SEASON HAVING COME 2ND TO OXTED AND THEY'VE ABSOLUTELY HELD THEIR OWN IN THIS DIVISION AS WE EXPECTED THEY WOULD. THEY CURRENTLY SIT IN 9TH PLACE HAVING PICKED UP SOME VERY NOTABLE RESULTS INCLUDING A 5-2 THUMPING AGAINST BATTLE AND A 1-0 WIN V WESTFIELD. THEIR RECENT FORM HAS TAKEN A BIT OF A DIP BUT THEIR MOST RECENT FIXTURE BEING A NARROW 2-1 LOSS TO TITLE-CHASERS RINGMER, DESPITE HAVING A BARE 11. AIDEN COPPER USED TO CAUSE US ALL SORTS OF TROUBLE DOWN THEIR LEFT HAND SIDE WHEN WE CLASHED IN THE CHAMPIONSHIP AND BETWEEN THEM, HARRI NOURSE AND HENRY TAYLOR HAVE NOTCHED 14 GOALS THIS SEASON.

HAVING BEEN MISSING A FEW LAST WEEK, WE'RE BACK UP TO STRENGTH THIS WEEK WITH DAVE MAC AVAILABLE AND NATHAN MADIMBA RETURNING FROM SUSPENSION. SHANE O'KEEFFE IS A DOUBT HAVING SUSTAINED AN INJURY AGAINST COPTHORNE AND CHARLIE GAUNTLETT WILL REMAIN WITH THE RESERVES WHO HAVE A CUP SEMI-FINAL TODAY, SO BEST OF LUCK TO THEM!

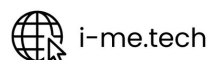

MATCH REPORT

POINTS SHARED IN EASTBOURNE

REIGATE PRIORY FC TRAVELLED TO THE SOUTH EAST COAST TO PLAY EASTBOURNE UNITED ASSOCIATION, 6 POINTS CLEAR OF OPPOSING TEAMS BENEATH THEM. HOWEVER, EASTBOURNE WERE GOING TO PROVE A STERN TEST, CONTAINING MANY PLAYERS OF THE SIDE THAT WON THE MID SUSSEX PREMIER DIVISION LAST SEASON.

DALE WYATT'S PRIORY SIDE STARTED THE GAME THE BETTER SIDE, AS THEY ONLY ALLOWED EASTBOURNE 2 ATTACKS INTO THEIR HALF IN THE FIRST 30 MINUTES. PRIORY GOT THEIR REWARD FOR A FIRST START NEAR THE 25TH MINUTE MARK, WHEN A DELIGHTFUL MOVE STARTED BY LOANEE HARRY MARK RECYCLING THE BALL OUT TO THE LEFT FROM THE HALFWAY LINE LEADING TO A COMBINATION OF MATT HARRINGTON AND HARRY DOWNER, WHERE HARRINGTON MANAGED TO SWING IN AN INCH PERFECT CROSS ONTO THE HEAD OF CALLUM JOHNSON, WHO HEADED HOME PAST THE ONRUSHING EASTBOURNE GOALKEEPER.

EASTBOURNE ARGUABLY ENDED THE LAST 15 MINUTES OF THE FIRST HALF THE BETTER AND GOT THEIR REWARD JUST BEFORE HALF TIME. AN IN-SWINGING CORNER HUNG UP IN THE WIND, WHICH WAS A CONSTANT BATTLE THROUGHOUT 90 MINUTES SWINGING IN OFF THE COAST, AND LANDED IN THE PRIORY 6 YARD BOX FOR A TAP IN. 1-1 AT HALF TIME, ALL TO PLAY FOR.

EASTBOURNE CAME OUT AFTER HALF TIME A MUCH IMPROVED SIDE, GENERATING A FEW MORE ATTACKING OPPORTUNITIES IN THE SECOND HALF. HOWEVER, NEITHER TEAM COULD IMPOSE THEMSELVES ON A TIGHT GAME. ALTHOUGH, EACH SIDE HAD OPPORTUNITIES TO WIN THE GAME. EASTBOURNE'S STRIKER PAUL ROGERS MISSED A FREE HEADER FROM A CROSS, PRIORY'S JOHNSON HAD A SIMILAR OPPORTUNITY WHICH HE COULDN'T CONVERT AND JOHNSON ALSO HAD A PENALTY SHOUT IN THE LAST MINUTES NOT GIVEN BY THE REFEREE.

ALL IN ALL A TIGHT GAME, RESULTED IN A DRAW, WHERE BOTH TEAMS MAY HAVE THOUGHT THEY SHOULD HAVE WON THE GAME.

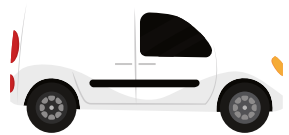

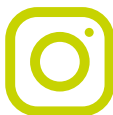
